"The Book: A Contemporary View"

is an exhibition that explores the book in contemporary art. It will be on view at the Delaware Center for the Contemporary Arts from December 22, 2010—April 17, 2011.

This exhibition will look at the different approaches to the book taken by contemporary artists. These approaches include artist-made books, pop-up books, comic books, graphic novels, and both three-dimensional and two-dimensional artworks that explore and stretch definitions of the "book."

The DCCA is searching for artists who want to make proposals for works, including installations, or from those who already have works that are relevant to the topic.

This is not a juried show, but the curator is asking for all interested artists who want to be considered for participation in the exhibition to contact her with a CD of available works (JPEGs, 300 dpi or higher), a resume, an artist statement, and a proposal if you want to suggest a new work not available for view on the CD. **Deadline: September 17, 2010**
