Any participants who have not already decorated their vehicle will be able to decorate their vehicle prior to the race from 12 pm to 3 pm. Race begins at 3 pm.

Teams must sign in on race day no later than 2:30 pm.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST SIGN A WAIVER. PARTICIPANTS UNDER 18 YEARS OLD MUST HAVE A SEPARATE RELEASE FORM SIGNED BY A LEGAL GUARDIAN.

DCCA Kinetic Sculpture Race Rules:

- Sculptures must be human powered. No Stored energy, motors, electricity (unless it is human generated).
- Sculptures must not pose any danger to anything near them, no open flame, no pointy objects.
- Sculptures must be decorated and all team members must be in appropriate costumes.
- Sculptures must be able to stop safely and quickly, no sculptures that fail break safety check will be allowed to compete.
- Sculptures must be no wider than 6 ft.
- Costumes are mandatory.
- All team members must wear approved helmets.
- Sculptures must stay on course; those that detour for any reason other than breakdown will be disqualified.
- Team members that begin with the sculpture must remain with the sculpture throughout the event.
- Participants must follow the directions of event coordinators, volunteers, police escorts etc...
